

Promotion

- Use the poster enclosed with the pack to promote the event (photocopies can be made)
- Ask your parish priest to place a note in the parish newsletter
- Make sure you let people know that the event is for bccs and order some of our free materials such as balloons and information leaflets

Fundraising

- Charge an entry fee per person, or per team. We would suggest you ask your participants to donate £5 per person. It is best to try and sell tickets in advance so that you can get an idea of how many people will be attending the event, especially if you are providing refreshments or need to set out table and chairs.
- To make the most of your event you might want to include some additional fundraising such as holding a raffle.
