YOUR EXPERIENCE

Here's an outline of what you can expect on the day

- 1 Training
 - An introduction to your team and what you can expect from your tandem skydive
 - Specialist training in a simulated environment
- 2 Safety
 - Full kit-up from the ground crew
 - Instruction & practice of free-fall & landing positions
 - Final training
- 3 Flight
 - Your personal tandem skydive instructor will escort you to the place and secure your harness
 - The plane departs above the scenic views of the Kent countryside
- 4 Freefall Skydive
 - You and your instructor will begin your high-adrenaline freefall from your chosen altitude, rushing at ~125mph (lasting for approximately 30-60 seconds depending on jump height)
- 5 Parachute Ride
 - At 5,000ft your instructor will deploy the parachute, slowing your decent to ~30mph, floating through the air towards your landing area
