How to get involved

Here are a few ideas to get started, but you might come up with some of your own.

A BCCS Bear for your family - You could set up a fundraising page on Just Giving and link it to our fundraising page here: https://justgiving. com/bccs. Ask your friends and family to donate a small amount at each family birthday or anniversary throughout the year and at Easter and Christmas. It all adds up and every donation will help us.
