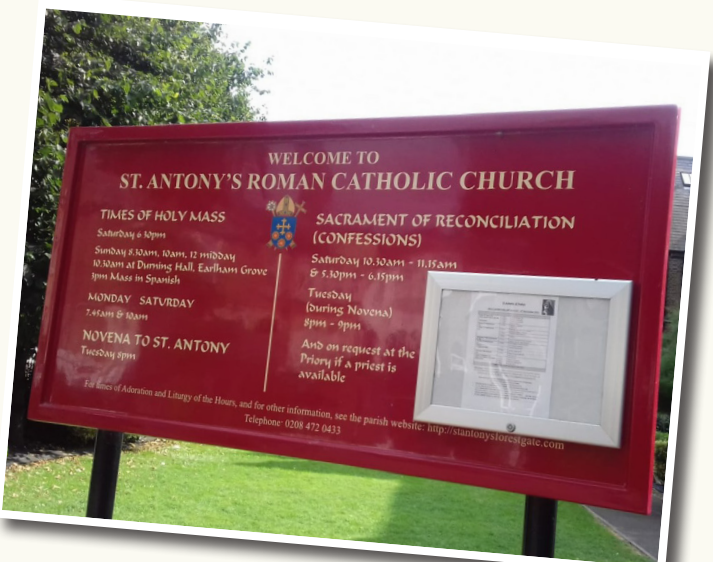






Nicola completed a circular route around legs 14, 15 and 16, starting at Christ the King in Chingford, and finishing there too!

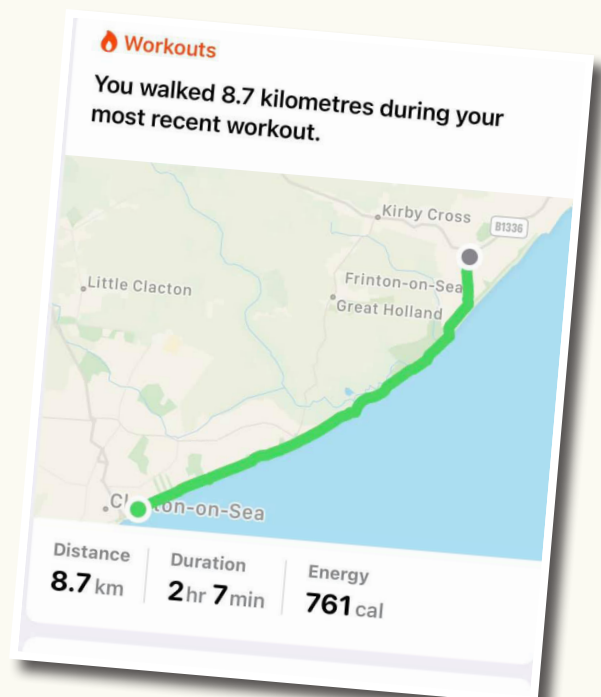
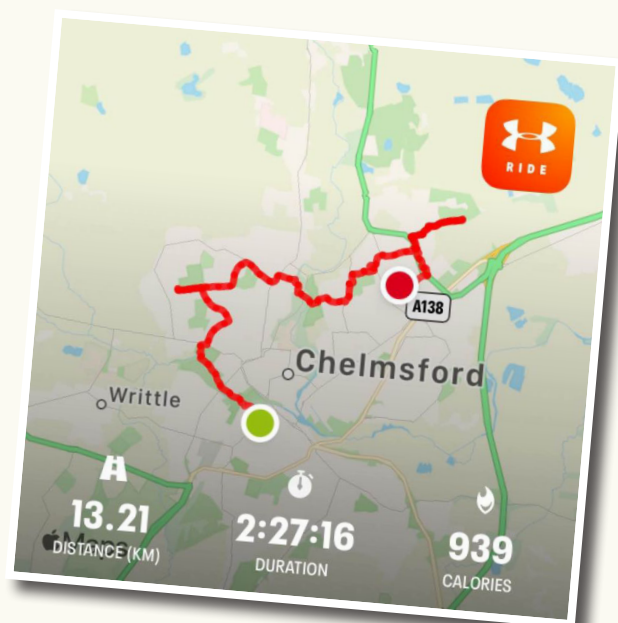
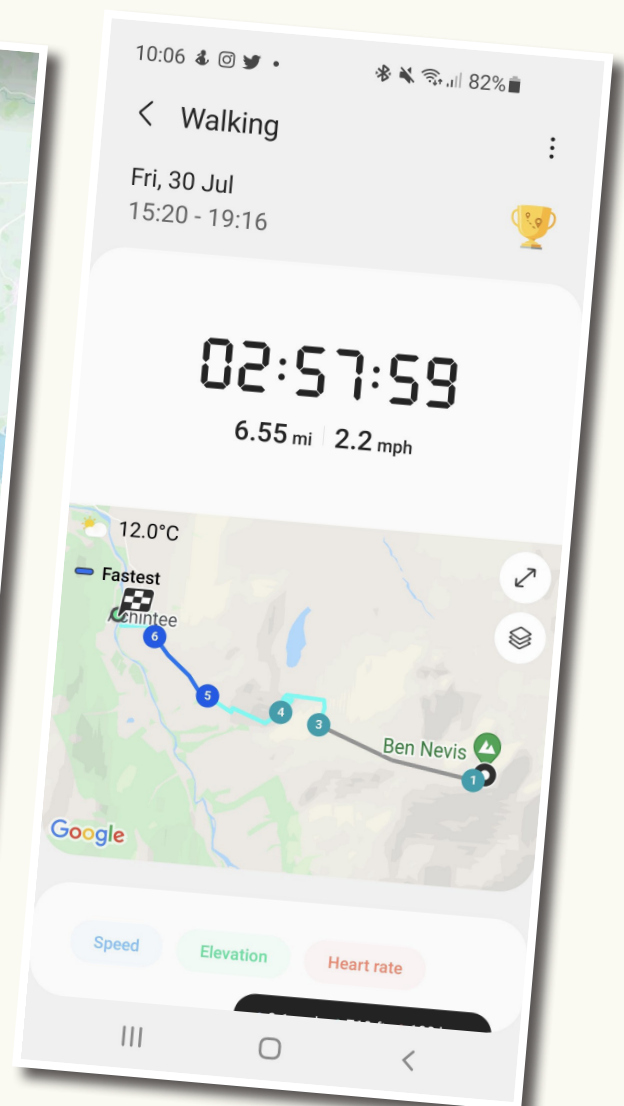


Top Left: Anthony rode for 6 hours in wet conditions cycling 109 miles from his home to cover leg 91 (10 miles) before he cycled home again.
